AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. DURBIN (for himself, Mr. LEAHY, Ms. BALDWIN, Mr. BOOKER, and Mr. MURPHY) to the amendment (No. 3867) proposed by Mr. REED

Viz:

1       At the end of subtitle F of title XII, add the fol-  
2       lowing:

3       **SEC. 1264. REPORT ON INCIDENTS OF ARBITRARY DETEN-**  
4                               **TION, VIOLENCE, AND STATE-SANCTIONED**  
5                               **HARASSMENT BY THE GOVERNMENT OF**  
6                               **EGYPT.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after the  
8       date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State,

1 in consultation with the Secretary of Defense, shall submit  
2 to the appropriate committees of Congress a report on in-  
3 cidents of violence against, and arbitrary detention and  
4 state-sanctioned harassment of, United States citizens, in-  
5 dividuals in the United States, and family members of  
6 such citizens and individuals carried out by the security  
7 agencies of the Government of Egypt in Egypt or the  
8 United States.

9 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report required by subsection  
10 (a) shall include the following:

11 (1) A detailed description of any such incident  
12 during the three-year period immediately preceding  
13 the date on which the report is submitted.

14 (2) A determination of whether such incidents  
15 constitute a pattern of acts of intimidation or har-  
16 assment.

17 (3) A description of any action taken by the  
18 Secretary of State to meaningfully deter such inci-  
19 dents.

20 (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)  
21 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may contain  
22 a classified annex with respect to the elements described  
23 in paragraphs (2) and (3) of subsection (b) if such classi-  
24 fied annex is provided separately.

1           (d) APPROPRIATE COMMITTEES OF CONGRESS DE-  
2 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate commit-  
3 tees of Congress” means—

4           (1) the Committee on Foreign Relations and  
5           the Committee on Armed Services of the Senate; and

6           (2) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the  
7           Committee on Armed Services of the House of Rep-  
8           resentatives.
